WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP?

- As a parent/carer you automatically become part of our Community Partnership; this is an essential link to Filton Avenue's continuing success.
- You will be a 'listening ear' to Filton Avenue's Leadership Team, as well as providing advice to the school and Governors on how Filton Avenue should move forward.
- We will schedule termly meetings at a range of different times, and on different days of the week, so that as many people as possible can attend.
- The meetings will last no longer than one hour and light refreshments will be provided.
- Unfortunately, we cannot provide crèche facilities, but parents/carers with children are welcome to attend.
- If you would like to attend then you simply come along to as many meetings as you can; there is no requirement to attend all the meetings.
- An agenda will be set for each meeting by the Leadership Team, taking in to consideration expressions of interest, as requested at previous meetings.
- Minutes of the meetings will be shared via the school's website and Facebook.
