COURSES WITH FEE WAIVERS

Some courses up to and including Level 2 may be eligible for certain types of government funding if you are aged 19+, which can help pay all or part of the course fee.


If you are unemployed and in receipt of certain benefits, then you might be able to obtain a Benefit Waiver, provided you meet the criteria and the course you wish to study is eligible.

If you are employed either full- or part-time, or are self employed and earn less than £16,009.50 per year, then you might be eligible for a Low Income Waiver, provided you can supply evidence of current employment and yearly income and the course you wish to study is eligible.

If you are 19–23 and you have not previously achieved a Level 2 or 3 course, then you might be eligible for Level 2 or 3 Entitlement Funding. You will need to supply evidence of previous qualifications (if applicable) and the course you wish to study must be eligible for this type of funding.
