Our Enrichment Curriculum

Filton Avenue Primary School understands that equality of opportunity is fundamental allowing all children to thrive and aspire. As such, we devote a whole day, in Term 2, 4 and 6, to Enrichment, which is designed to provide children with opportunities which wouldn't otherwise be available to all families.

The Enrichment curriculum focuses on providing **opportunities** which:

- Require expert tuition which would not be available to all families: Gymnastics, Circus Skills, Cheerleading, Silent Discos, and Bristol Sport Foundation etc.
- **Provide opportunities to practice skills linked to the states of being** in a range of contexts that would not be possible in a whole-class setting e.g. Art and Design, Theatre Dancing, Yoga etc.
- **Build respect, confidence, teamwork, collaboration, perseverance, and leadership skills:** children work within their class and year groups for enrichments activities.
- Provide opportunities for endeavor and purposeful practice to attain mastery: Enrichment courses provide children with the opportunity to practice new skills and allow for new 'WOW' experiences e.g. Virtual Tours, Virtual Zoos experiences and visiting the Wonders of the World

Parents and outside experts, alongside school staff, support or lead the enrichment courses which are available three times a year. An element of Sports Premium is used to support this.
