This time last year, we successfully launched our Community and Parent Advisory Group (CPAG). In case you missed it, or weren't yet a part of the school community, I'm sending you a document that gives more detailed information, as well as the minutes from both of our meetings. However, in a nutshell the CPAG is going to support our aim of enhanced community engagement, building on the great work that is already happening.

Listening and working well with school stakeholders is a key part of the school's work and principal among these is the parent community. The participation of parents and then the wider community is an important aspect of school leadership which provides important insights into the school.
