




















#### Theologian


As Theologians, children gain the chance to buil a deeper understanding of the world as well as their community. As a part of our curriculum, w learn about various religions and beliefs.




The religions that are taught are: Christianity, Buddhism, Islam, Hinduism, Sikhism and Judaism.


#### Anti-bullying


