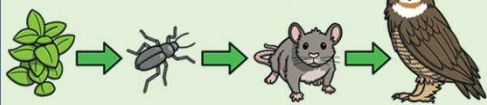

- Need food, water and air to stay alive



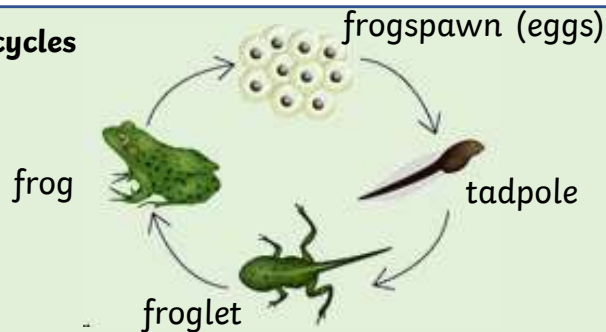

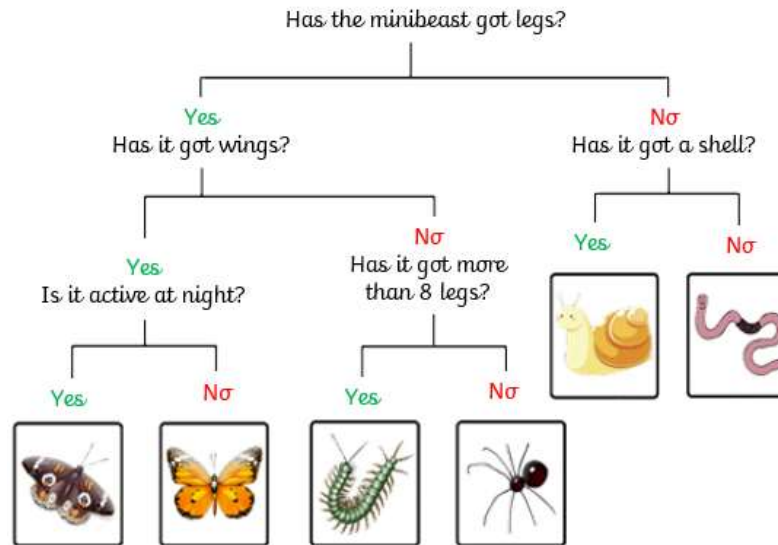
