

John Cabot


John Cabot (*Giovanni Caboto* in Italian) was an Italian explorer. He went on two **voyages** from Bristol.

His **first** voyage was on **the Matthew** and he set sail from **Bristol** in May 1497 with a crew of 18 men. He arrived in **America** in June 24th 1497. He named places he found after him and the voyage.

His **second** voyage was in 1498 with 5 ships and 200 men. It is believed the ships crashed near Ireland and that the crew died.



The Matthew



crew	A group of people working with someone. John Cabot had a crew working on the Matthew.
voyage	A journey. John Cabot made a voyage across the sea.
departure	Leaving somewhere
explorer	An explorer is someone who travels to find out about different places. Explorers travelled for different reasons and this can help us learn about the past.



Paul Stephenson led a **boycott** to allow Black and Asian bus drivers to work in Bristol. They won. The boycott was against racism in Bristol and led to the law being changed.
